Dear Friends,

Over the past month, I've typed the words "How are you doing?" more times than I can count. I've sent those words in emails and texts, spoken them on the phone and in video calls. I need to hear if my friends and loved ones are okay.

You may be wondering the same thing about Rangga. How is he doing?

Several times every week we get updates from each of the 25 countries where we serve. Our faithful staff is filing those updates and letting us know what regulations are in place, and how they are able to continue to minister, especially to the most vulnerable families.

I wanted to take a moment to share with you about the latest updates from Indonesia. I hope this will give you a glimpse into the life of your child now and also give you assurance that our partner churches around the world continue to serve and love your child.

Indonesia

The country has confirmed cases of COVID-19. Local governments have advised students to learn from home and not attend schools through the end of May, and all gatherings of more than 25 people have been banned. Nearly all Compassion child development centers are closed; a few continue limited activities. Compassion health specialists are providing videos and flyers on disease prevention and hygiene. Frontline church partners and Compassion staff continue to monitor the local situations. Beneficiaries are still able to access medical care, and staff is maintaining contact with families via phone.

May these updates give you powerful ways to pray for your sponsored child and the people of his country. This page is your best resource for the most up-to-date information from Compassion and is updated weekly. You can also visit our COVID-19 FAQ page if you have any additional questions.

I couldn't end this update without sharing some more good news with you! This blog post highlights some of the creative, amazing ways our staff, students and alumni are ministering during this global pandemic.
